Please understand that we do share call with Rapid City Medical Center. Therefore, there is a possibility that one of these providers may also be involved with your care or delivery. Additionally, Monument Health-Rapid City Hospital does have an OB Emergency Room with coverage provided by their own provider's that you may see.

After each visit, please make sure to have your next appointment scheduled before you leave the office. You will have an ultrasound at approximately 20 weeks gestation. This is when you may request information on the sex of your baby if you desire.

Please make sure to call the office if you have any questions or concerns. Our nursing staff is available to help answer any questions you may have. The office staff may request that you come into the office if there are any concerns that need to be addressed. Please be flexible and have patience as we may be working you in between other patients and you may need to wait. If you do present to the office for a concern not related to your pregnancy (i.e. upper respiratory infection, migraines, influenza, etc.) your insurance will be billed outside the global charge.

You are responsible for keeping your account paid throughout the pregnancy. You will be sent monthly statements if there is any balance on your account. The front office staff may request payment at your next appointment to reconcile accounts as soon as possible prior to delivery. If you have any questions regarding your bill, please call our office.
